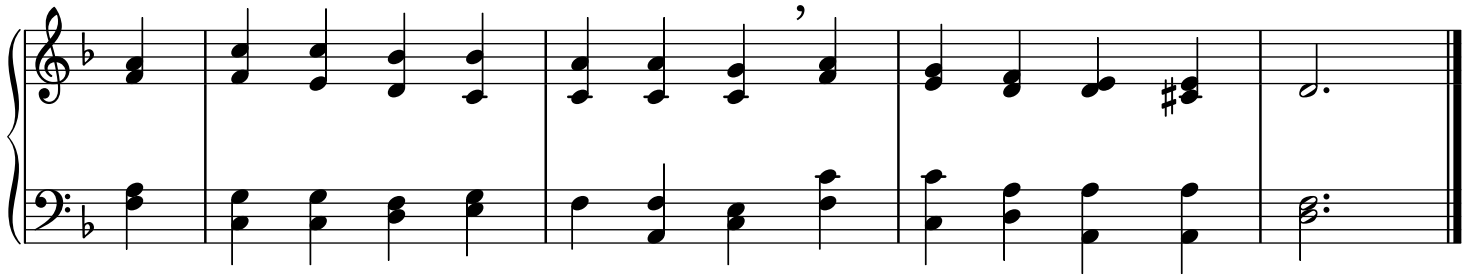


Μνήεο Χριτέ (Mnōeo Christe)
