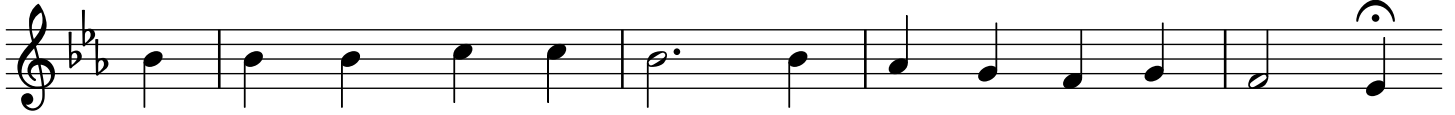


# Now Thank We All Our God

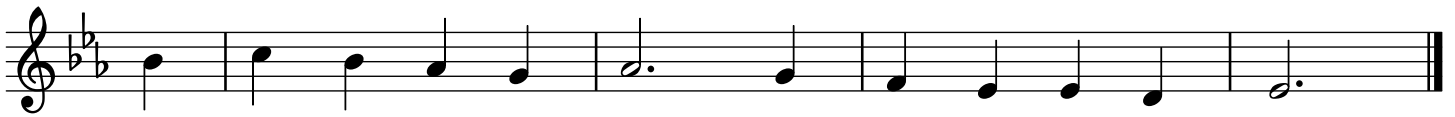
1. Now thank we all our God with hearts and hands and voices,
