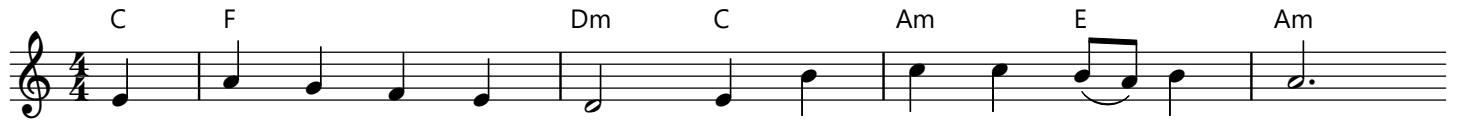


# O Sacred Head, Surrounded

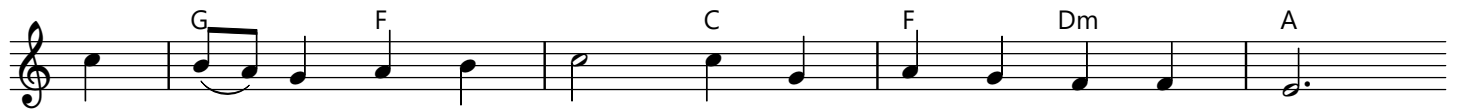
