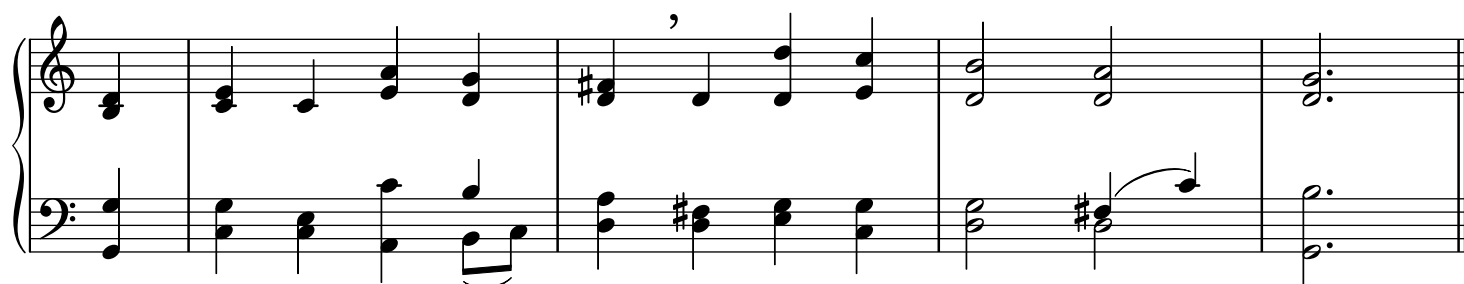
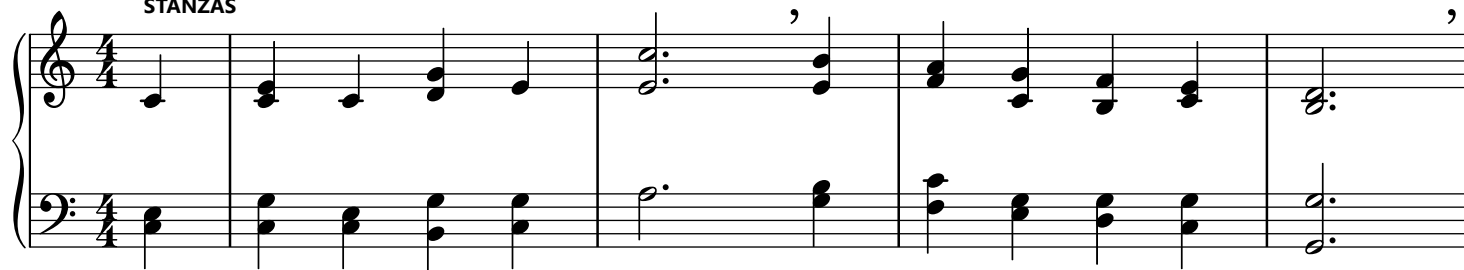


# Rejoice, the Lord Is King
