

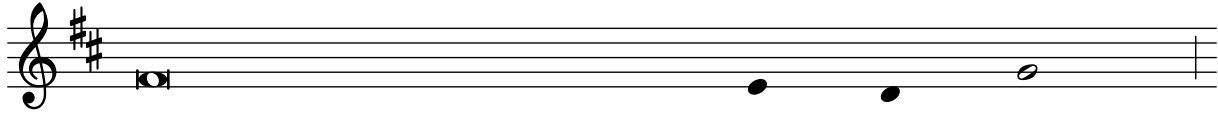

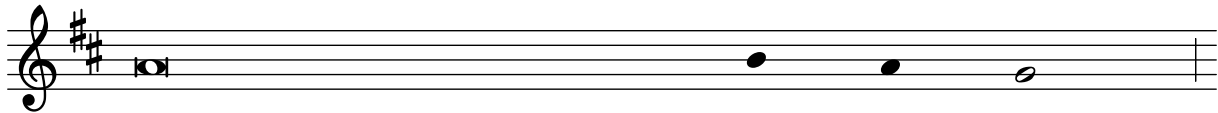

Psalm 96 (95): 1-2a, 2b-3, 11-13b, 13cd



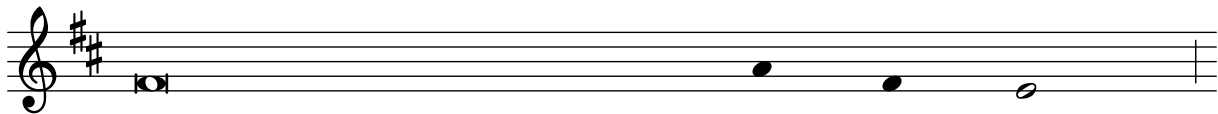
1. O sing a new song to the Lord,

4. With justice he will rule the world,



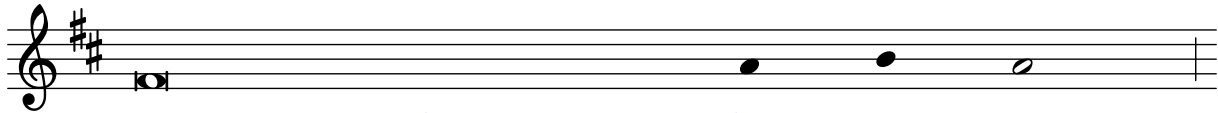
1. sing to the Lord all the earth.

3. let the sea and all within it thun - der praise,



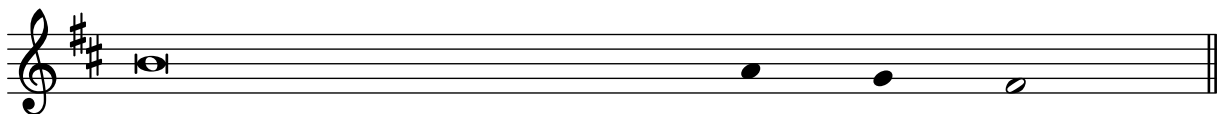
3. Let the land and all it bears re - joice,
