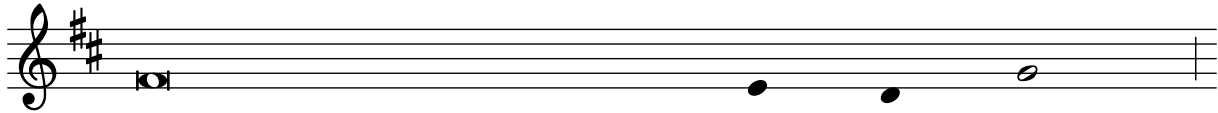

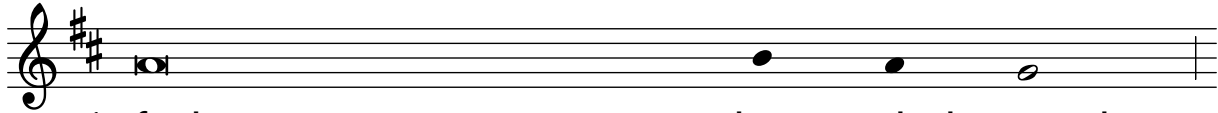

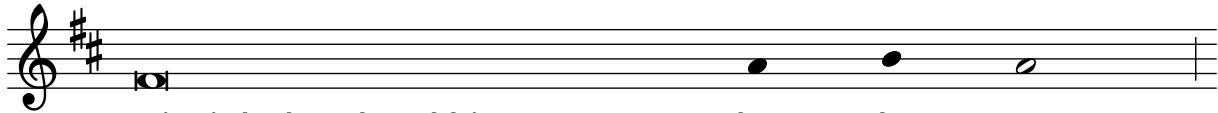
Psalm 98 (97): 1, 2-3b, 3cd+4ac, 5-6



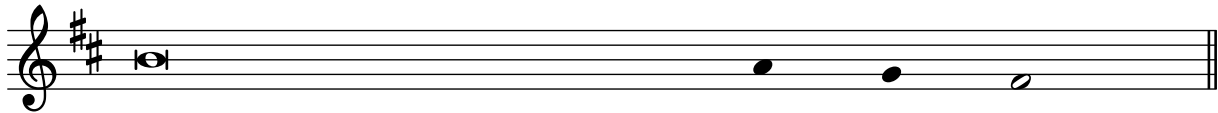
1. Sing a new song to the Lord
