





He has remembered his **merciful love**
and his truth for the **house of Israel**.

Shout to the LORD, all **the earth**;
break forth into **joyous song**,
and sing **out your praise**.
4. Sing psalms to the LORD with **the harp**,
with the harp and the **sound of song**.
With trumpets and the sound **of the horn**,
