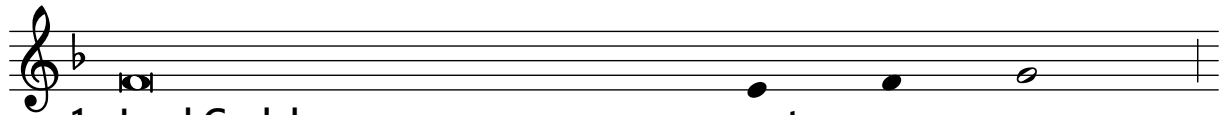

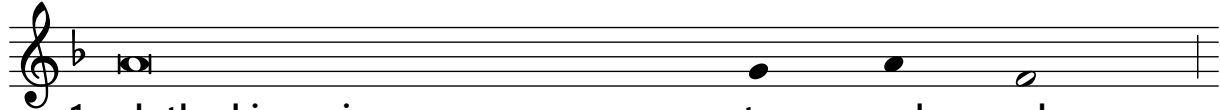

STANZAS Psalm Tone: 6

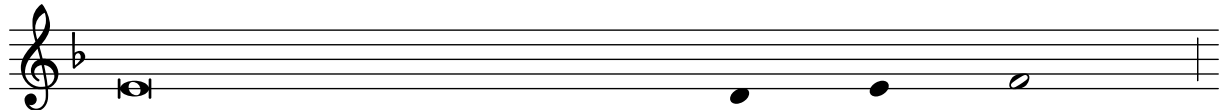
Psalm 104 (103): 1b-2, 3-4, 24-25, 27-28, 29b-30



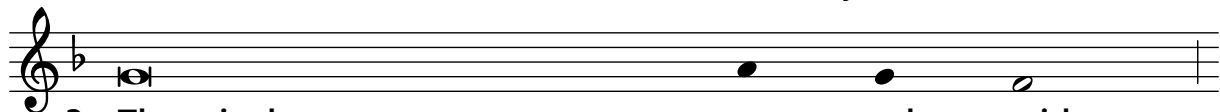
1. Lord God, how great you are,

5. You take back your spir - it, they die,



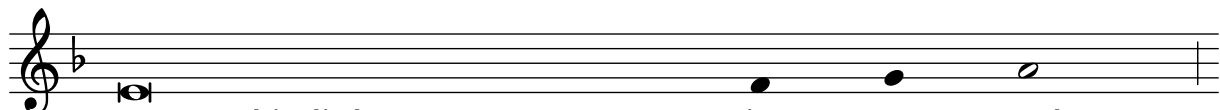
1. clothed in majes - ty and glory,

5. returning to the dust from which they came.



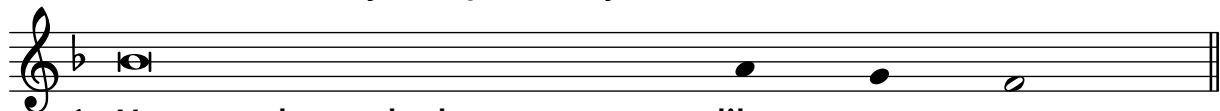
2. you walk on the wings of the wind,
