

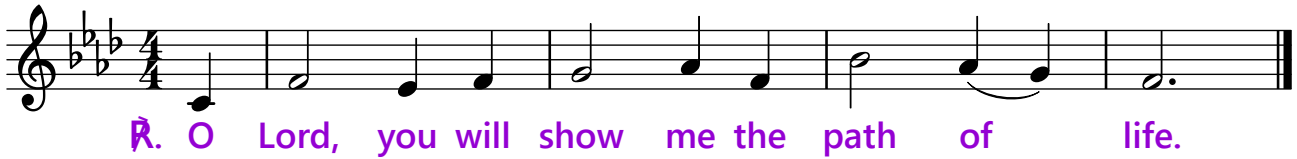

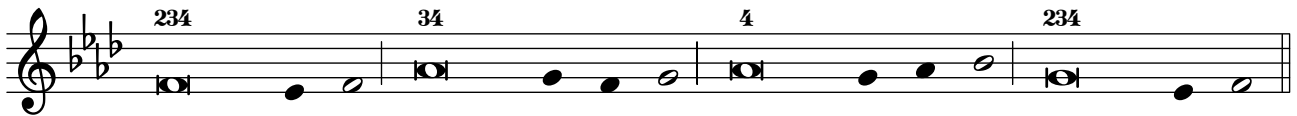

1. Preserve me, O God, for in you I **take** refuge.
I say to the LORD, 'You **are** my **Lord**.'
O LORD, it is you who are my **portion** and **cup**;
you yourself who secure **my** lot.
2. I will bless the LORD who gives **me** **counsel**,
who even at night **directs** my heart.
