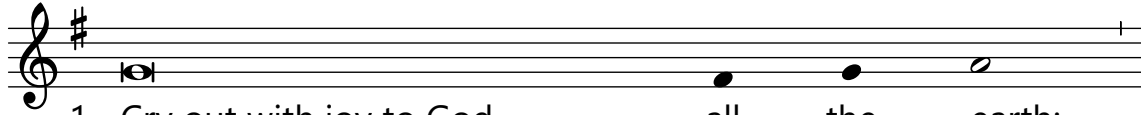

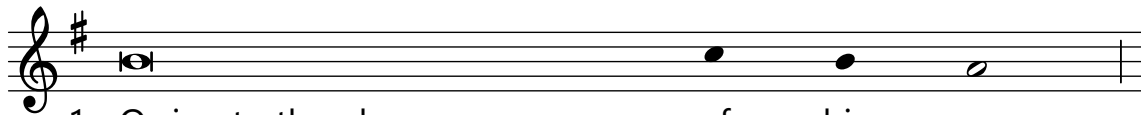

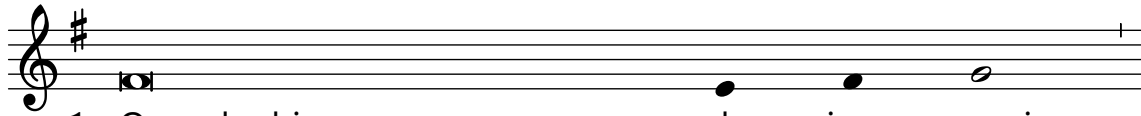
Psalm 66 (65): 1-3a, 4-5, 6-7a, 16+20



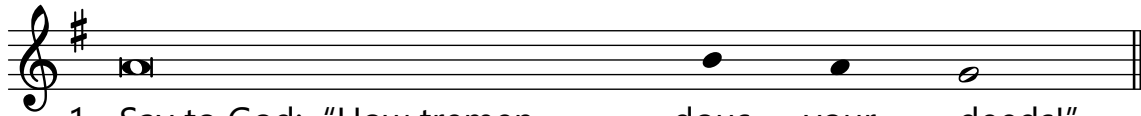
1. Cry out with joy to God, all the earth;
