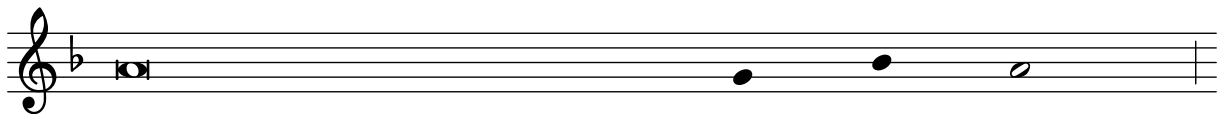
1. who follows not the counsel of the wicked,

3. For they like win - nowed chaff



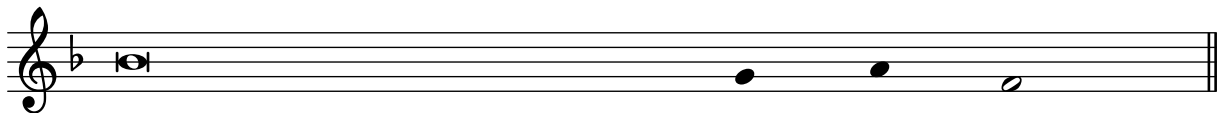
1. nor lingers in the way of sinners
