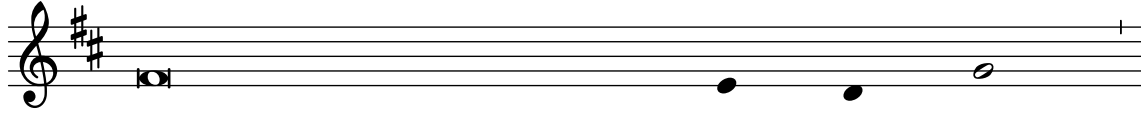

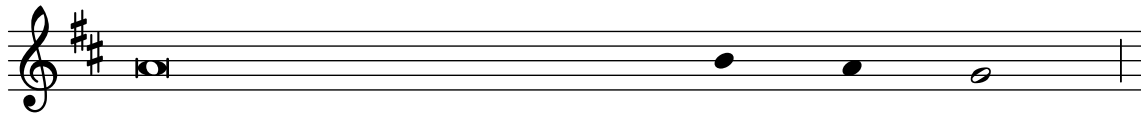

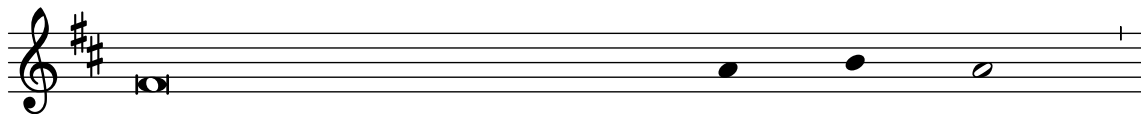
Psalm 103 (102): 1-2, 3-4, 8+10, 12-13



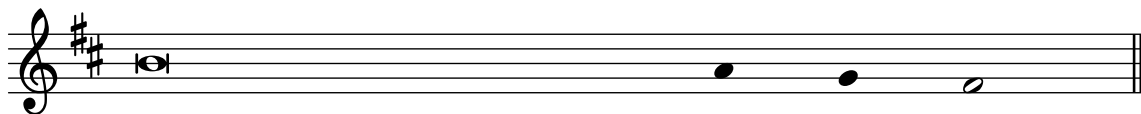
1. My soul, give thanks to the Lord,
