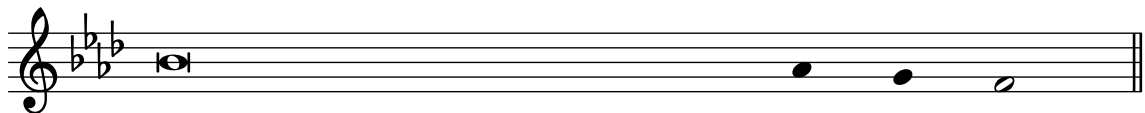
1. I will sing for ever of your love, O Lord;
