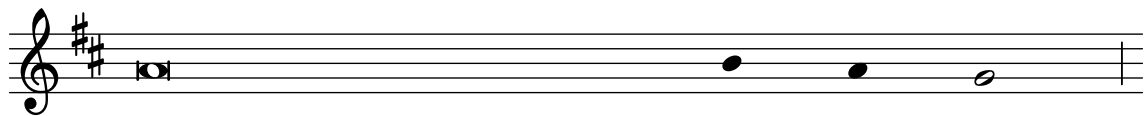

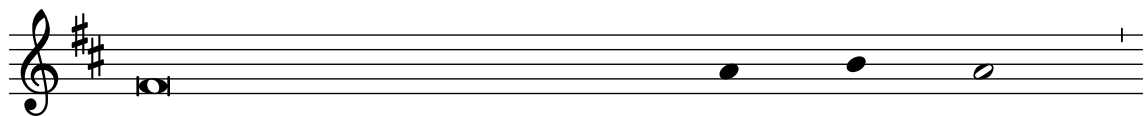

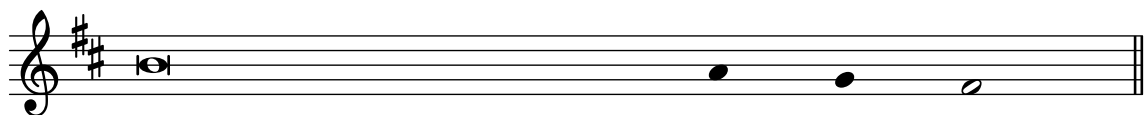
1. My soul, give thanks to the Lord,
