

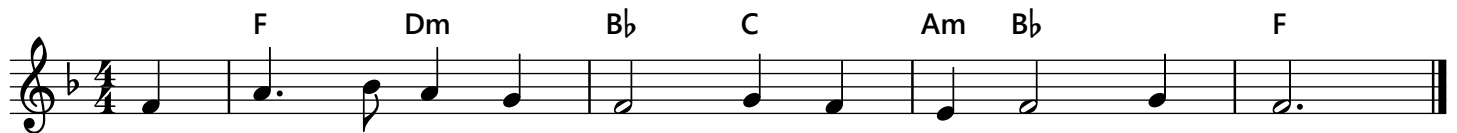

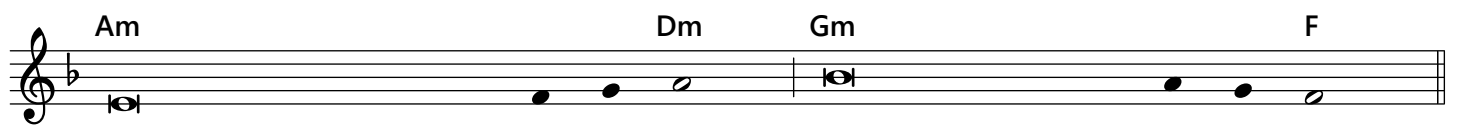
Psalm 121 (120): 1-2, 3-4, 5-6, 7-8
