

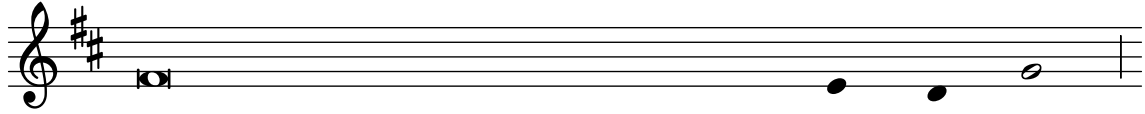

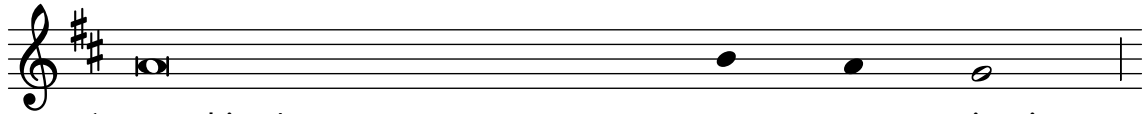

STANZAS Psalm Tone: 5

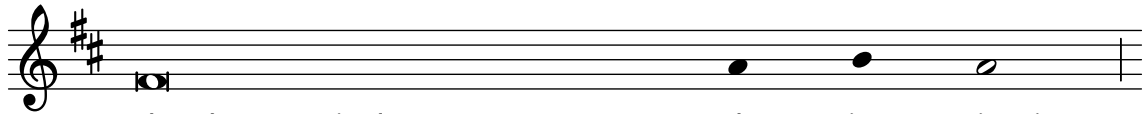
Psalm 72 (71): 1-2, 3-4b, 7-8, 12-13, 17



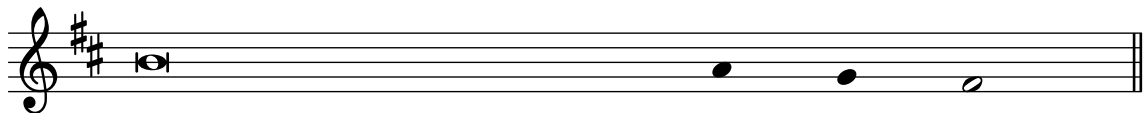
1. O God, give your judgment to the king,
