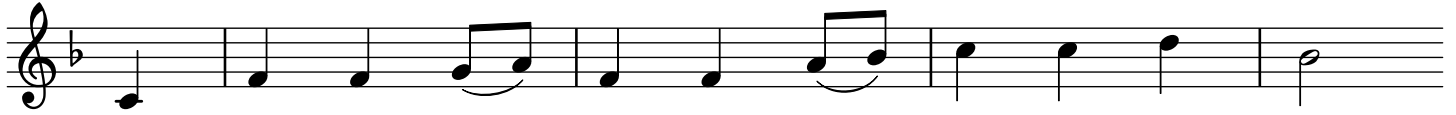


Away in a Manger, No Crib for a Bed

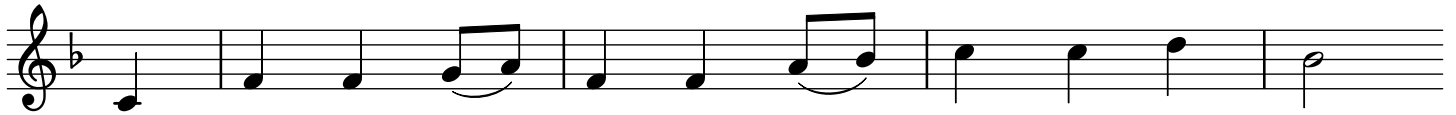
