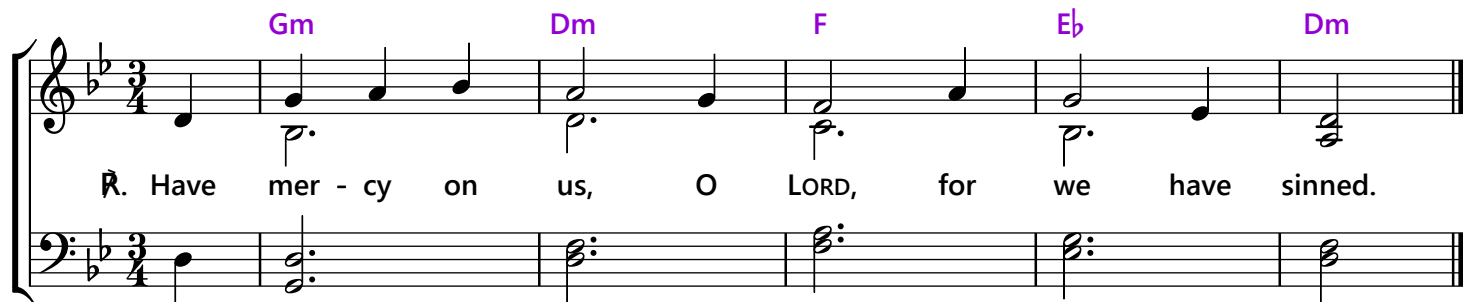

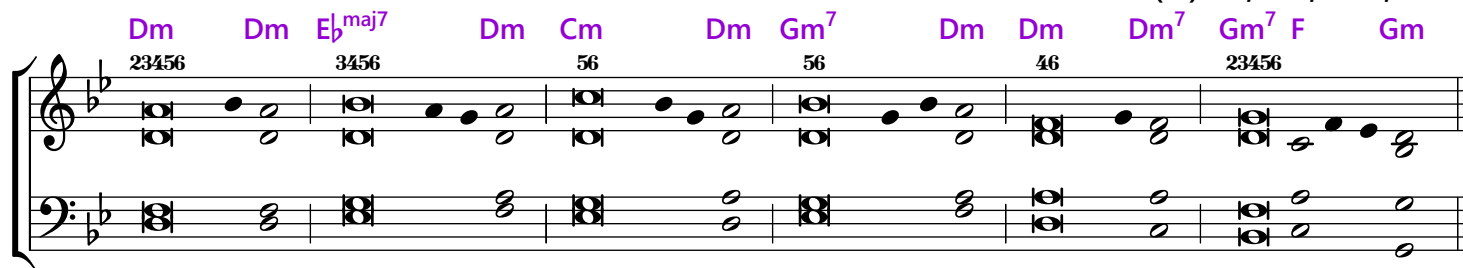

Psalm 51 (50): 3-4, 5-6b, 12-13, 14+17



1. Have mercy on me, O God, according to your merciful love; according to your great compassion, blot out my transgressions. Wash me completely from my iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin.

2. My transgressions, truly I know them, my sin is always before me. Against you, you alone, have I sinned; what is evil in your sight I have done.

3. Create a pure heart for me, O God; renew a steadfast spirit within me. Do not cast me away from your presence, take not your holy spirit from me.

4. Restore in me the joy of your salvation, sustain in me a willing spirit. O LORD, open my lips and my mouth shall proclaim your praise.

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
