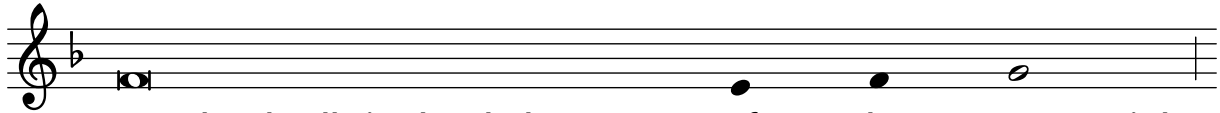

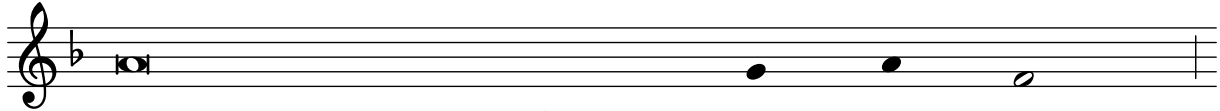

STANZAS Psalm Tone: 6

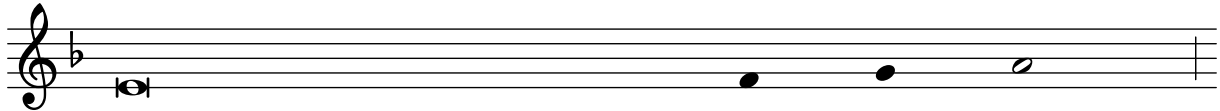
Psalm 91 (90): 1-2, 10-11, 12-13, 14-15



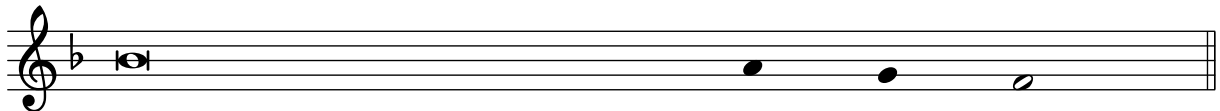
1. He who dwells in the shelter of the Most High
