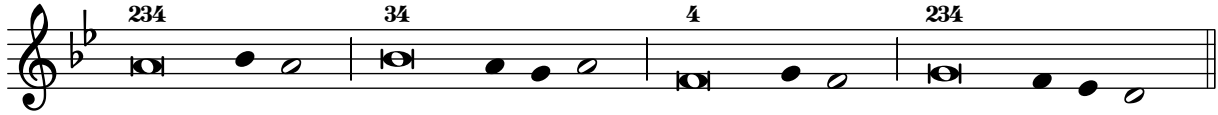
Psalm 27 (26): 1a
