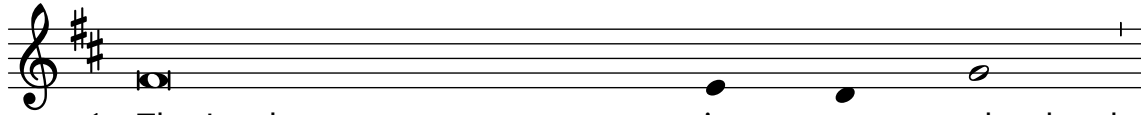

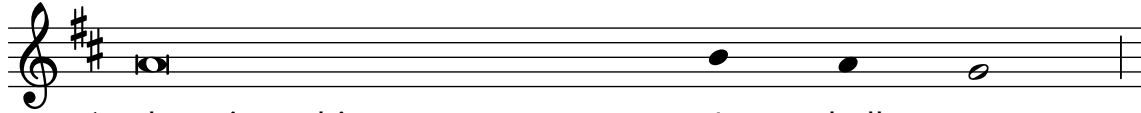

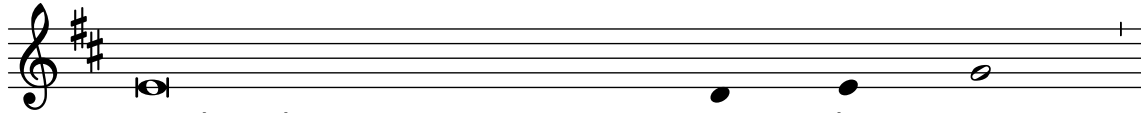
Psalm 23 (22): 1-3a, 3b-4, 5, 6



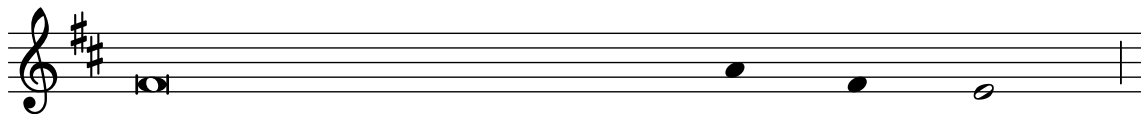

4. Surely goodness and kind - ness shall follow me



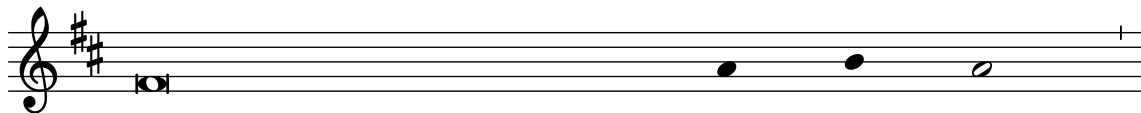

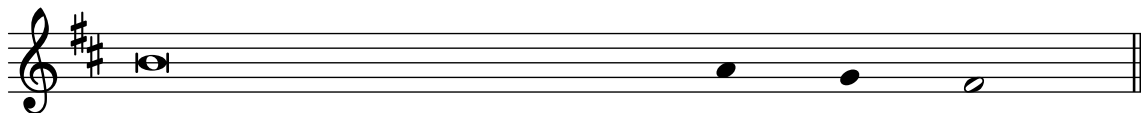
