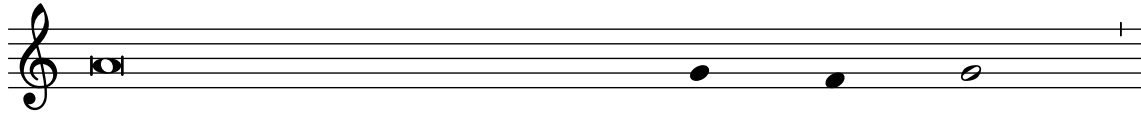

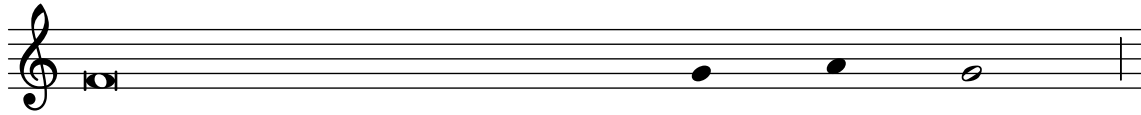

STANZAS Psalm Tone: 4

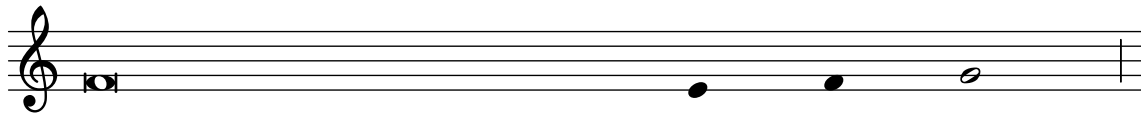
Psalm 31 (30): 2+6, 12abcd, 12e-13, 15-16a, 17+25



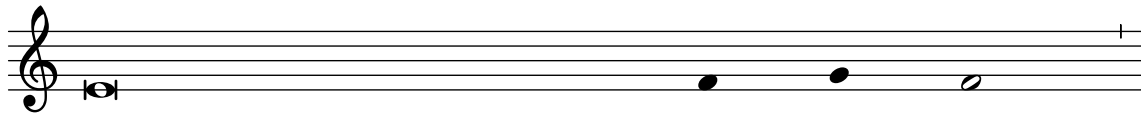
1. In you, O Lord, I take refuge.

5. Let your face shine on your servant.



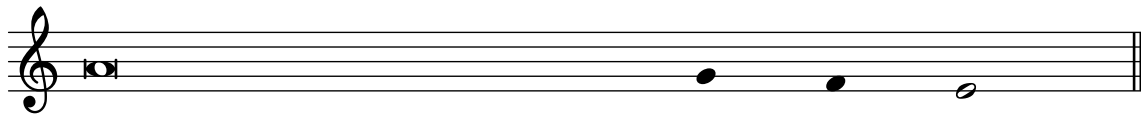
1. Let me never be put to shame.
