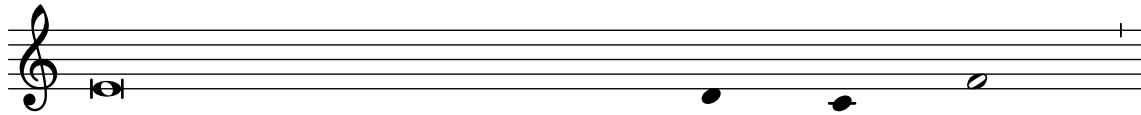

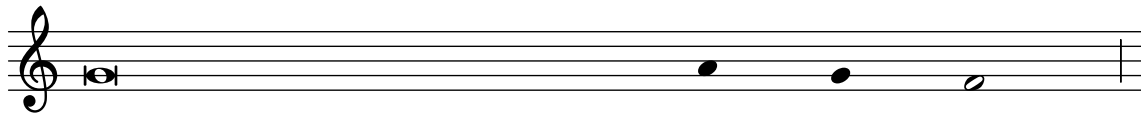

STANZAS Psalm Tone: 5

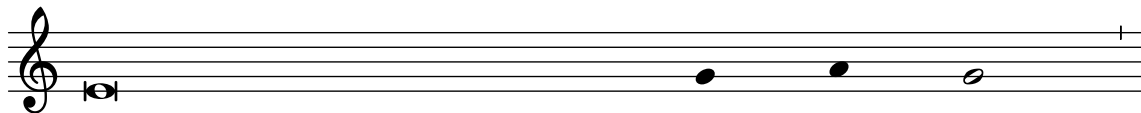
Psalm 104 (103): 1-2a, 5-6, 10+12, 13-14, 24+35c



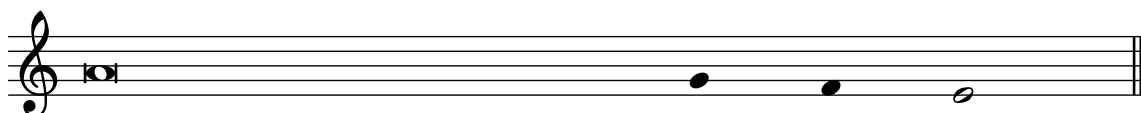
1. Bless the Lord, my soul!
