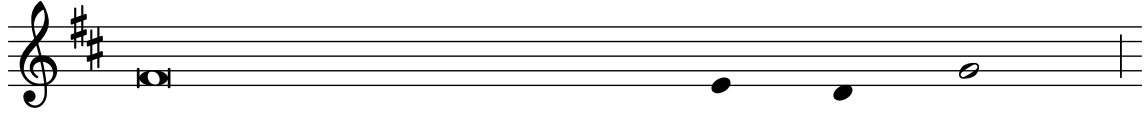

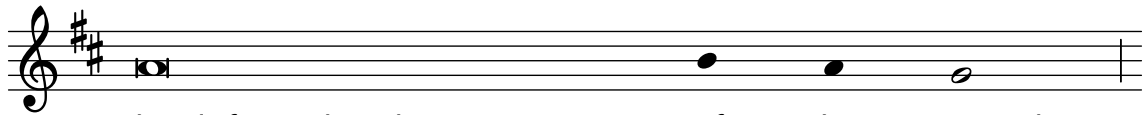

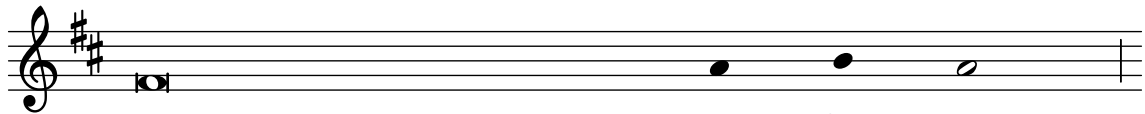
Psalm 33 (32): 10-11, 12-13, 14-15



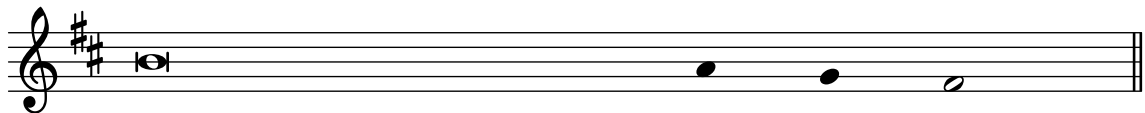
1. He frustrates the designs of the nations,
