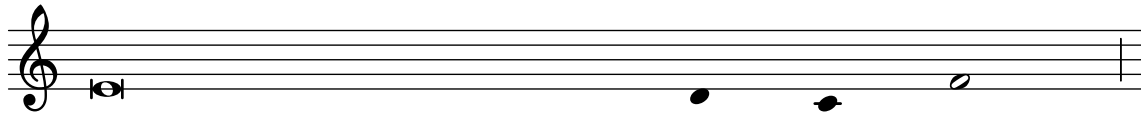

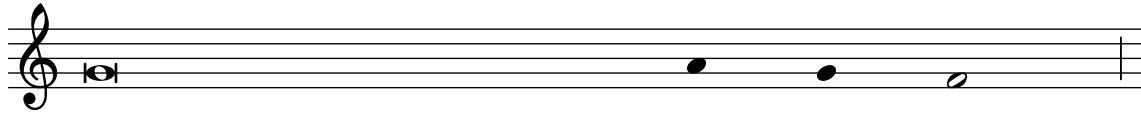

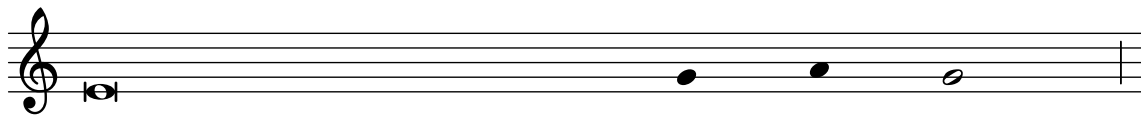
Psalm 104 (103): 1-2a, 24+35c, 27-28, 29b-30



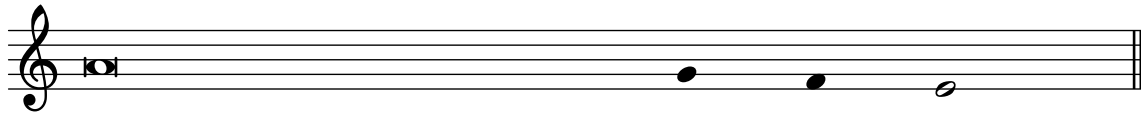
1. Bless the Lord, my soul!
