STANZAS Psalm Tone: 5

Psalm 104 (103): 1-2a, 24+35c, 27-28, 29b-30

1. Bless the Lord, my soul! Lord God, how great you are,
 2. How many are your works, O Lord! In wisdom you have made them all.
 3. All of these look to you to give them their food in due season
 4. You take back their Spirit - it, they die, returning to the dust from which they came.

 2. The earth is full of your riches. Bless the Lord, my soul.
 3. You give it, they gather it up: you open your hand, they have their fill.
