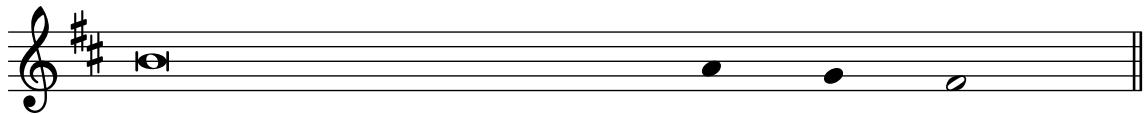
1. The word of the Lord is faithful
