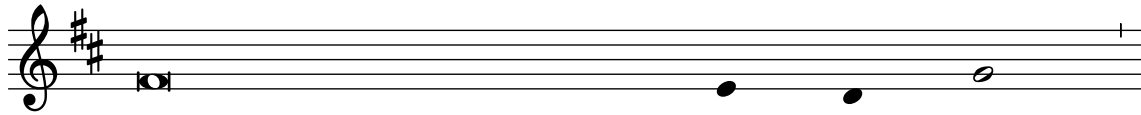

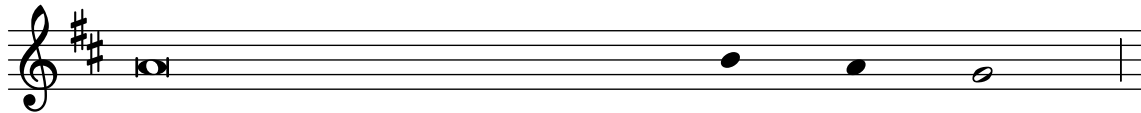

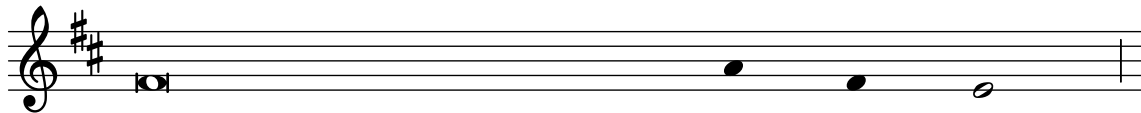
Psalm 40 (39): 2+4ab, 7-8a, 8b-9, 10



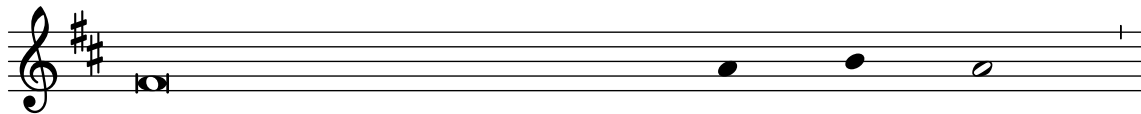
1. I waited, I waited for the Lord

4. Your justice I have pro - claimed



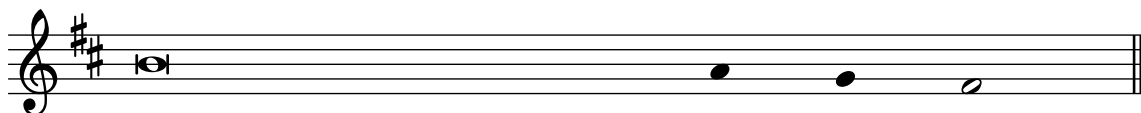
