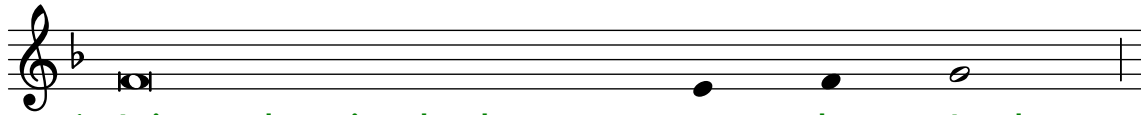

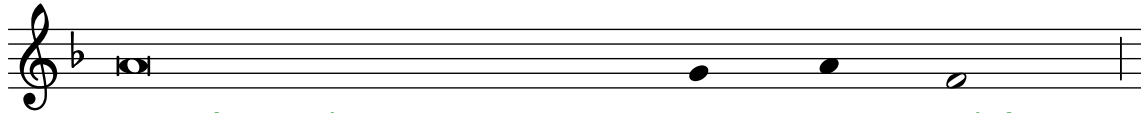

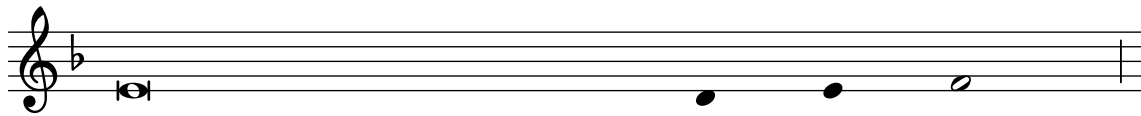
Psalm 92 (91): 2-3, 13, 14-16



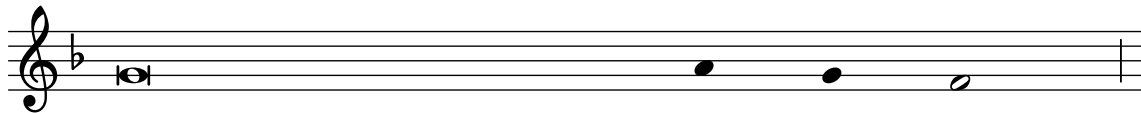
1. It is good to give thanks to the Lord

3. Planted in the house of the Lord



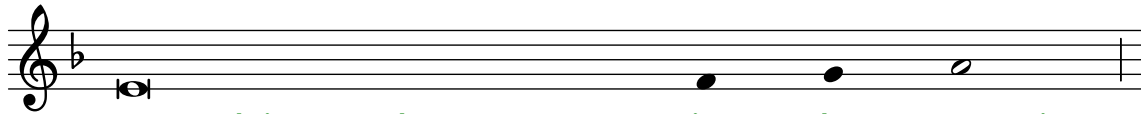
1. to make music to your name, O Most High,  
3. they will flourish in the courts of our God,



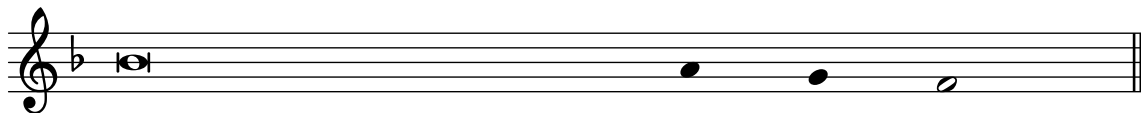
3. still bearing fruit when they are old,
