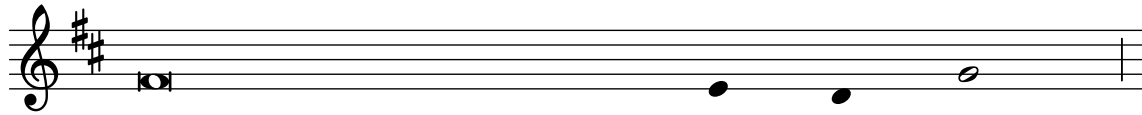

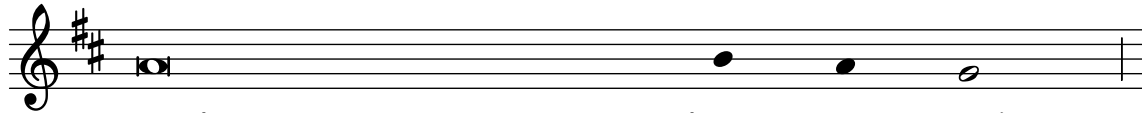

STANZAS Psalm Tone: 5

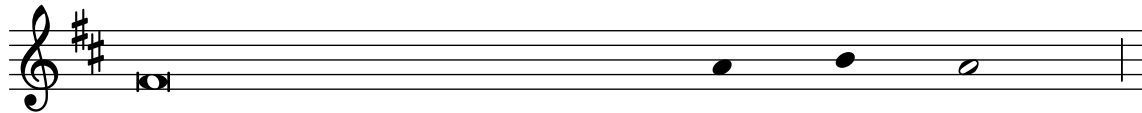
Psalm 130 (129): 1-2, 3-4, 5-6b, 7b-8



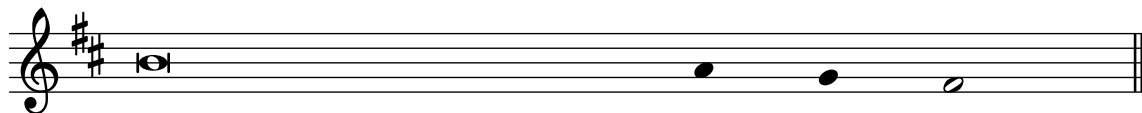
1. Out of the depths I cry to you, O Lord;
