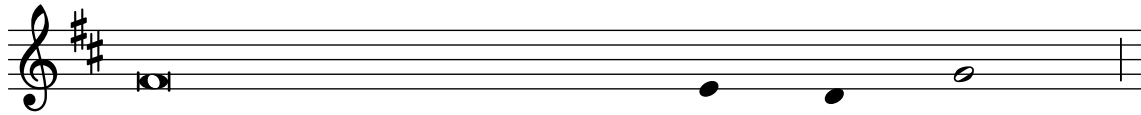

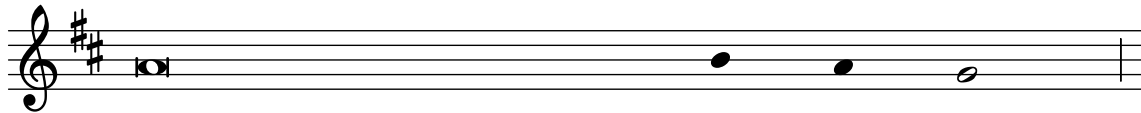
## Responsorial Psalm, Year B [McKenna]

STANZAS Psalm Tone: 5

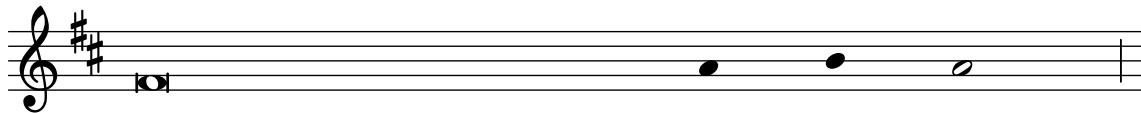
Psalm 107 (106): 23-24, 25-26, 28-29, 30-31



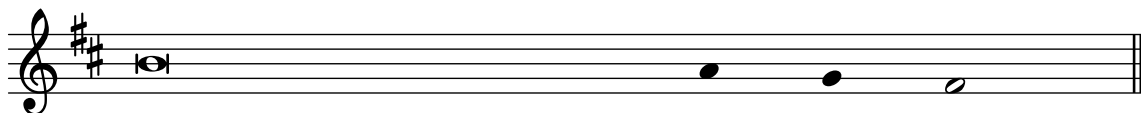
1. Some sailed to the sea in ships
