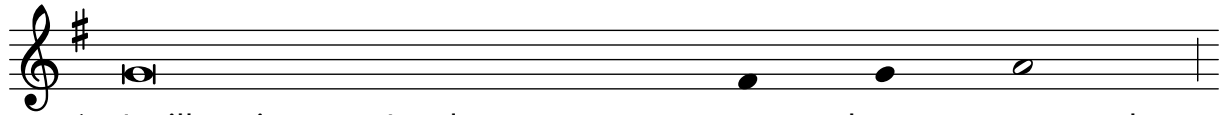

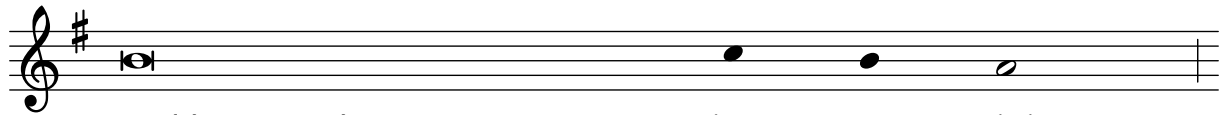
## Responsorial Psalm, Year B [Keefe]

STANZAS Psalm Tone: 7

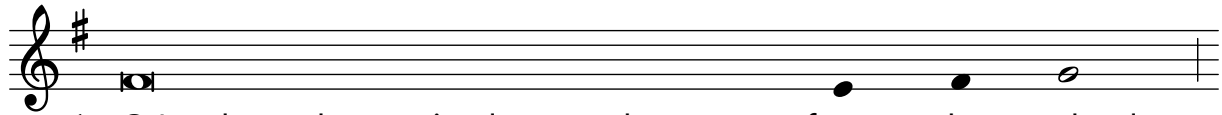
Psalm 30 (29): 2+4, 5-6, 11-12a+13b



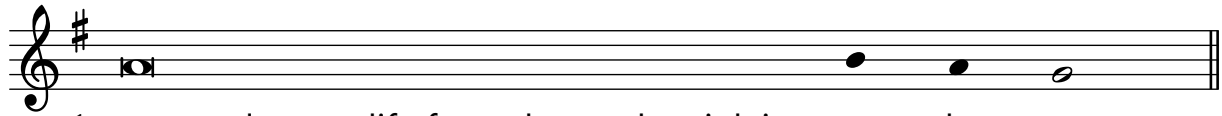
1. I will praise you, Lord, you have rescued me
