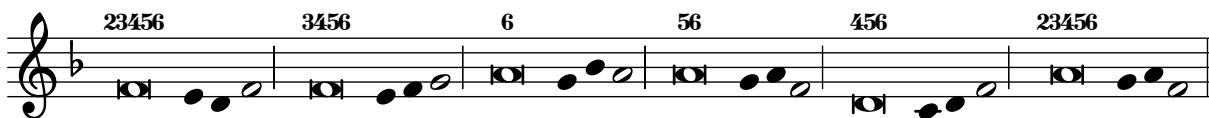
Psalm 23 (22): 1
