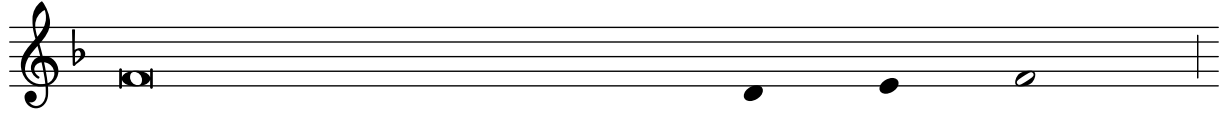

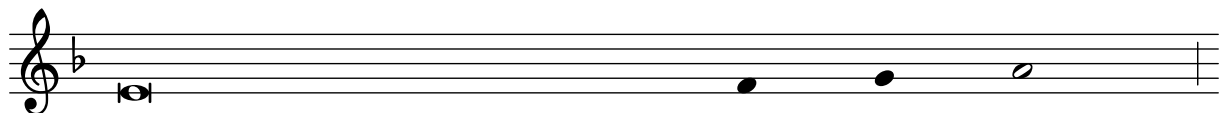

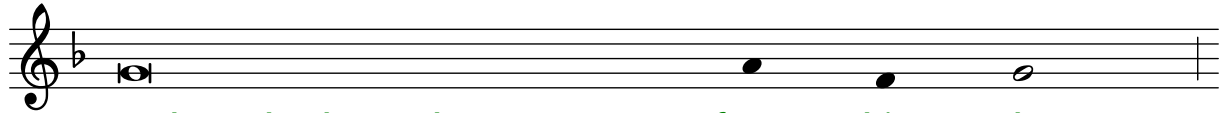
1. Lord, who shall dwell on your ho - ly mountain?

3. He who keeps his pledge, come what may;



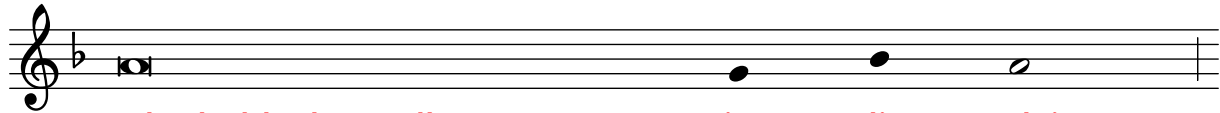
1. He who walks with - out fault;

3. who takes no interest on a loan



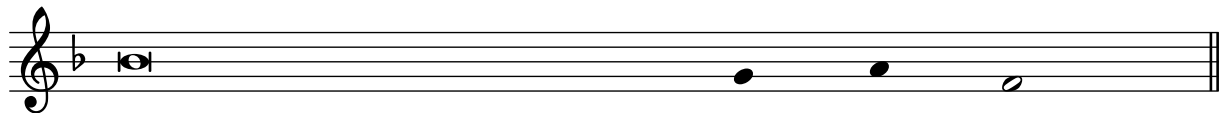
1. he who acts with justice
