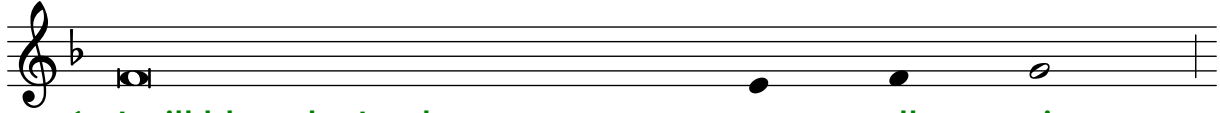

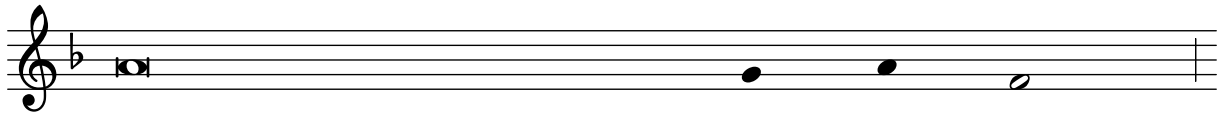

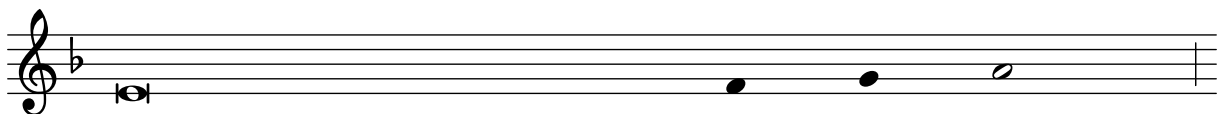
Psalm 34 (33): 2-3, 4-5, 6-7, 8-9



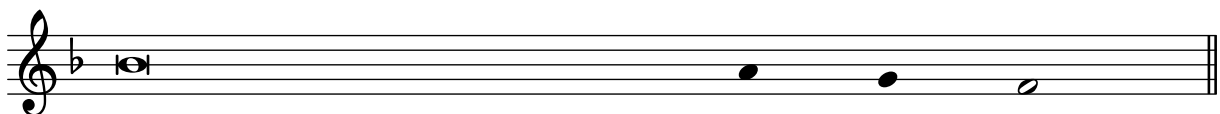
1. I will bless the Lord at all times,
