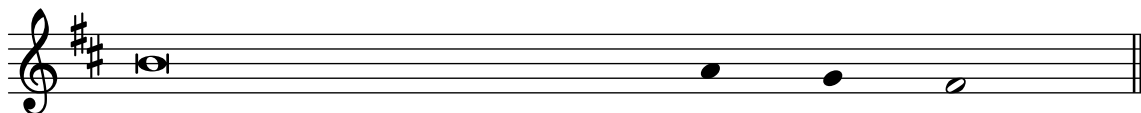
1. Ring out your joy to the Lord, O you just;
