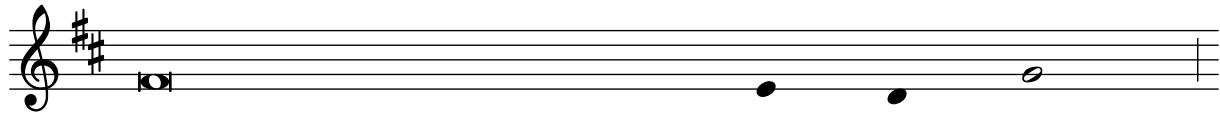

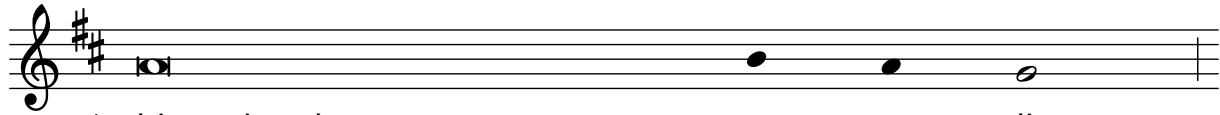

STANZAS Psalm Tone: 5

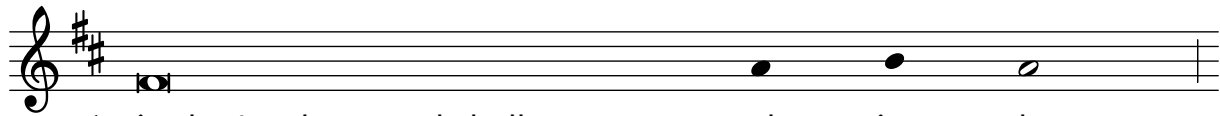
Psalm 34 (33): 2-3, 10-11, 12-13, 14-15



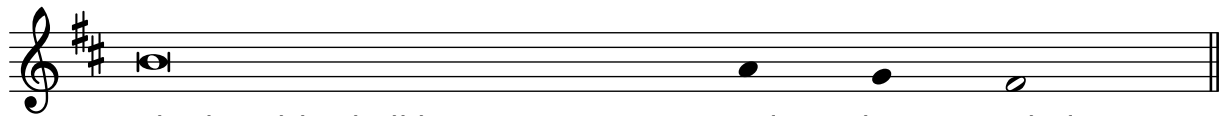
1. I will bless the Lord at all times,
