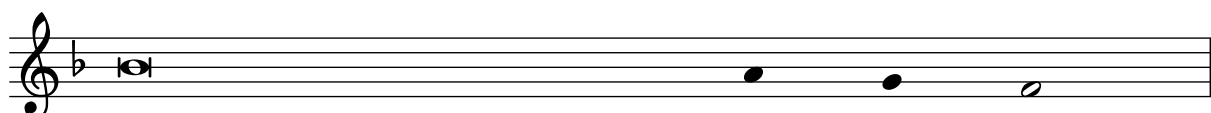
1. I will bless the Lord at all times,
