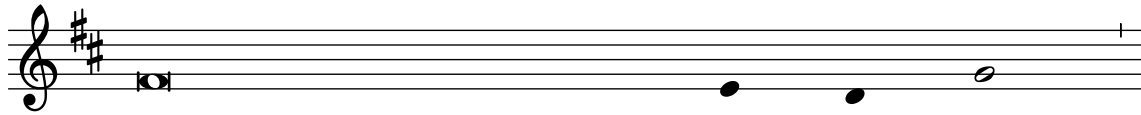

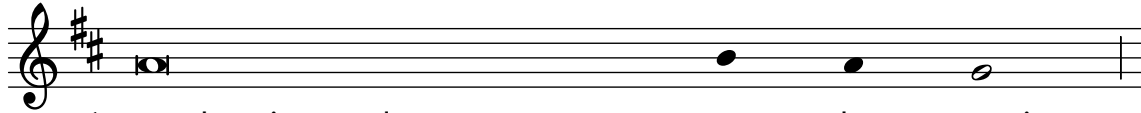
## Responsorial Psalm, Year A [McKenna]

STANZAS Psalm Tone: 5

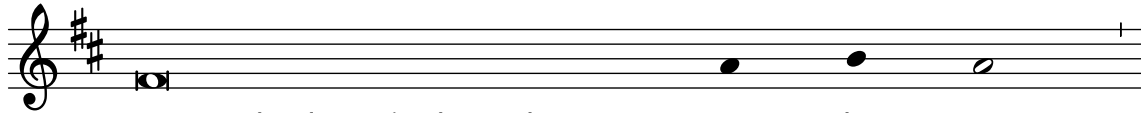
Psalm 80 (79): 9+12, 13-14, 15-16a, 19-20



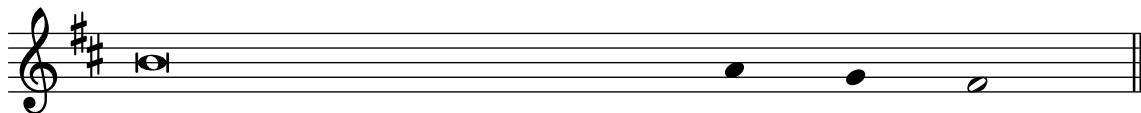
1. You bought a vine out of Egypt;
