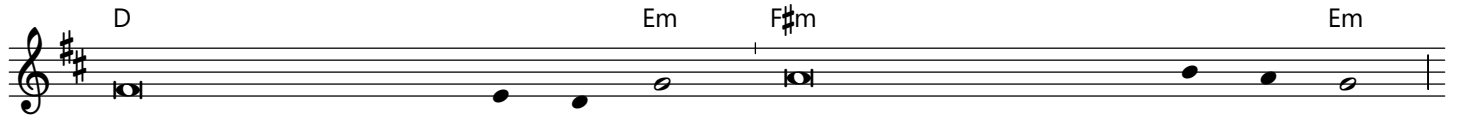


# 27<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time

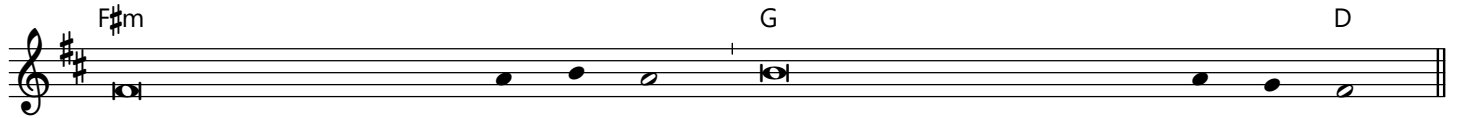
## Responsorial Psalm, Year A [McKenna]
