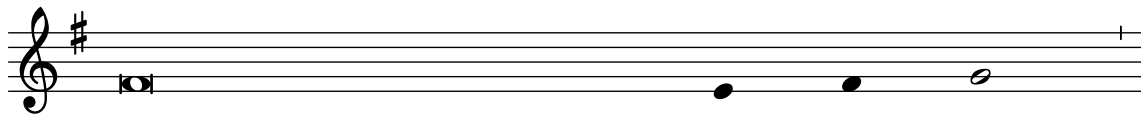
Psalm 96 (95): 1+3, 4-5, 7-8, 9+10a



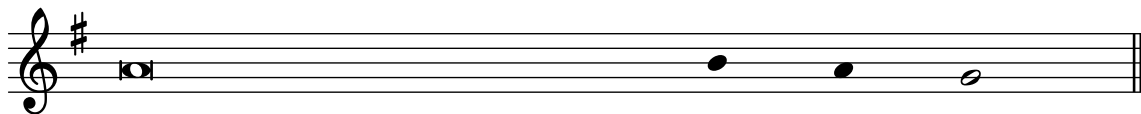
1. O sing a new song to the Lord,
