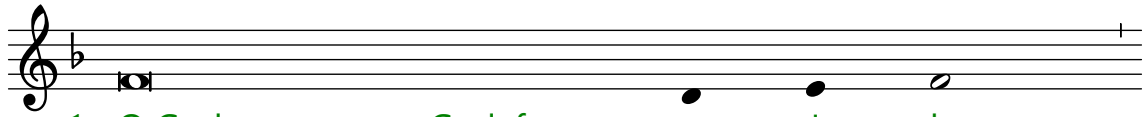

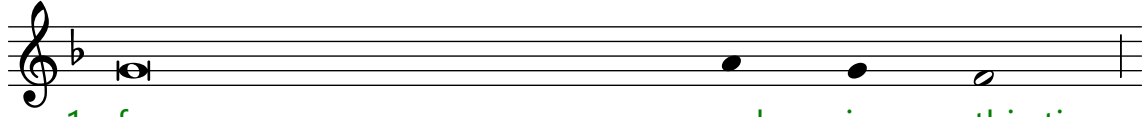

STANZAS Psalm Tone: 1

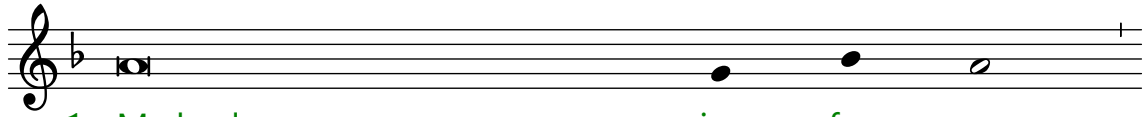
Psalm 63 (62): 2, 3-4, 5-6, 7-8



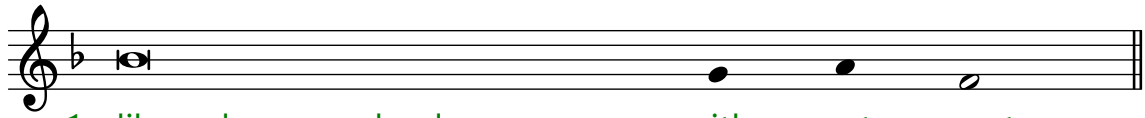
1. O God, you are my God, for you I long;
