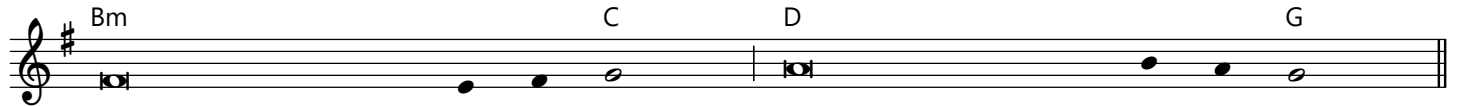
Responsorial Psalm [Amanda McKenna]
