

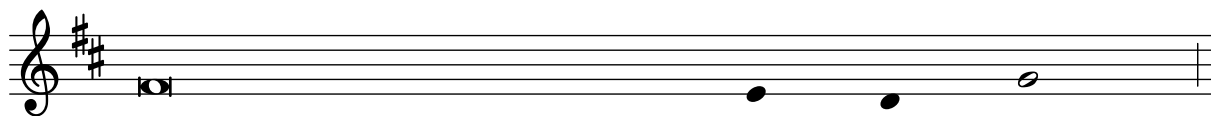

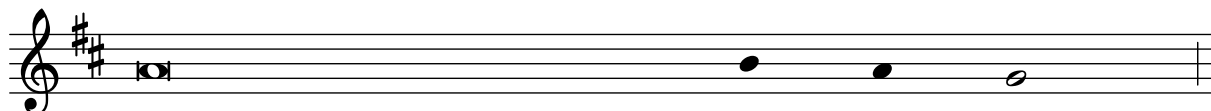

STANZAS Psalm Tone: 5

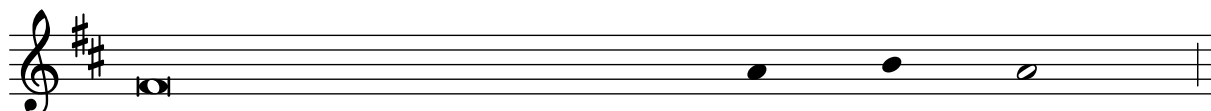
Psalm 78 (77): 1b-2, 34-35, 36-37, 38



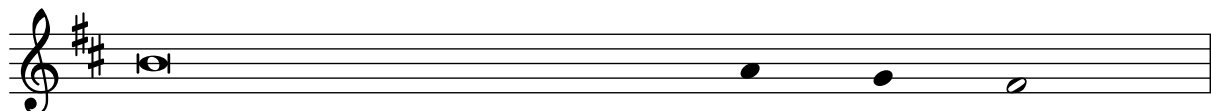
1. Give heed, my people, to my teaching;
